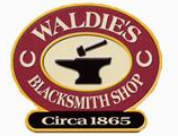

BASIC BEGINNER LEVEL ONE

Basic beginner introductory class where you will learn the traditional art of blacksmithing

Instructor: Mr. Darwyne Hourie

Date: Saturday, March 17, April 21, October 20

Time: 9 am to 5 pm

Cost: \$100.00

Some of the things that will be taught include: fire lighting; hammering techniques; drawing out steel etc.

Students will complete two simple projects.

BEGINNER LEVEL TWO

Beginner introductory class where you will learn the traditional art of blacksmithing. Must have taken level one or have some previous experience in smithing.

Instructor: Mr. Darwyne Hourie

Date: June 8, 9, 10 & Nov. 16, 17, 18 (Friday, Saturday, Sunday)

Time: Friday 6-10 pm; Saturday and Sunday 9-6 pm

Cost: \$300.00

Beginner course intended to develop basic skills. Some of the things that will be taught include: starting a fire; introduction to tools; hammering techniques etc.

Heat-treating and tempering will be introduced.

Students will complete various projects, which they will take home.

- Students will be supplied with: an anvil, hammers, safety glasses
- Students must wear natural fibre clothing (cotton or wool); a hat; leather shoes/boots; gloves
- Students should bring their own brown bag lunch
