### Times

Programs are approximately 1 ½ to 2 hours in length

- 9:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. or
- 1:00 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.

### Cost

- *Cost:* \$2.00 per student - minimum \$30  
(One teacher / parent supervisor per 15 students is required & admitted free)
  - Payment in full must be made a minimum of two weeks in advance
  - In the event of a cancellation being made two weeks or less prior to the confirmed date, the refund amount will be subject to an administrative fee and the minimum payment of \$30; therefore, a total of \$35 will be deducted from the total payment, or requested.

### General Information

- All visits include hand on activities using materials from the Archives.
- It is important that children know the dangers of playing with fire and the consequences of touching items which they are not suppose to. It is the onus of both the teachers and Blacksmith tour guides to ensure the safety of the children at all times.
- There are no facilities available for children to eat their lunch. This should be taken into consideration when booking visits.
- Play clothes and sturdy closed-toed footwear are recommended due to the nature of the Blacksmith Shop.

Programs can be altered to accommodate specific class or curriculum needs.
